

Between Africa and South America: dilemmas and challenges for Brazil in South-South cooperation

To analyze - with an emphasis on Brazil's role and performance - the meanings, dynamics and limits of South-South cooperation in the fields of regional integration, economic and technological cooperation, and social, environmental and migratory policies among the states of the Global South; and to analyze the political cooperation that takes place in international organizations among actors from the Global South. In order to achieve this goal and build upon previous research developed within the scope of LABMUNDO, this research proposal expands both the territorial and the thematic dimensions to be investigated, favoring an analysis that produces new syntheses and evinces the complexity of the actors and agendas of international cooperation, the contradictions inherent to cooperation processes, and the conceptual, political and strategic challenges posed by South-South Cooperation processes.
